Action Recommended: Approve the following Lane Economic Committee Bylaw Revision

The following change will remove term limits from LEC Bylaws. Term limits were instituted in 1999. The LEC sees term limits as a potential impediment to efficient operation. The LEC believes that it has had sufficient member turnover in recent years without needing to impose term limits

III.3 Tenure The term of office for a voting member shall be three years. ~~Members shall not serve more than three consecutive terms. Former members may reapply for appointment after a term out of office.~~ If a member is appointed to represent government, that member may serve on the LEC representing government only as long as the member continues in the member's government position. A vacancy shall be declared when a member representing government no longer holds a government position.
