

RESOLUTION 2008-01

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING COORDINATED POPULATION FORECASTS FOR THE URBAN GROWTH BOUNDARIES WITHIN LANE COUNTY, OREGON

WHEREAS, ORS 195.025(1) provides that counties are responsible for coordinating all planning activities affecting land uses within the county, including planning activities of the county, cities, special districts and state agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Office of Economic Analysis (OEA) is responsible for making population projections for the state and counties and the board of county commissioners or an authorized local coordination body is responsible for allocating the projected county population among the cities and the county; and

WHEREAS, at its December 14, 2006, meeting the LCOG Board of Directors received requests from four Lane County cities for a reassessment of Coordinated Population Forecasts, last adopted in February 2005, and directed its staff to bring together representatives of Lane County and its twelve cities to consider revising the previous Forecasts; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that direction, LCOG staff, using existing sources of population projections, historic trends and input from the staff of the county and cities within Lane County, has allocated the OEA population projection for Lane County among the county and its cities; and

WHEREAS, the allocated population projections have been reviewed by the cities within Lane County prior to their submission to the Board of Directors of the Lane Council of Governments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Lane Council of Governments that:

Section 1. The “Population Forecasts for Urban Growth Boundary Areas in Lane County,” as set forth in Appendix B of the “Report on Lane County Coordinated Population Forecast—2030-2035,” attached hereto, is hereby endorsed.

Section 2. The “Population Forecasts for Urban Growth Boundary Areas in Lane County,” as set forth in Appendix B of the “Report on Lane County Coordinated Population Forecast—2030-2035,” is hereby referred to the Lane County Board of Commissioners and recommended for final adoption and use in future land use, transportation and public facility planning by the affected jurisdictions.
