

Appointment of Non-Metro-City RIB Member Background Statements

DON HAMPTON BIOGRAPHY

Don Hampton, a retired teacher, has lived in the Oakridge area for 40 years. He has served on the Oakridge City Council for the past fifteen years, five as the mayor. He has also served on the LCOG Board of Directors and the Regional Investment Board of Directors (as well as its executive committee).

Other leadership positions which Don has held include the Area Health Education Center of SW Oregon Board of Directors (chair in 2005), member of the Oregon Education Association's Board of Directors and the LRAPA (Lane Regional Air Protection Agency) Board of Directors.

Awards which Don has received include nominations in 1992 and 1997 for the Oregon Educational Media Teachers Association's "Media Teacher of the Year," three presidential citations from the president of the Oregon Education Association for leadership, a Certificate of Merit from the U.S. Forest Service for exemplary job performance and LCOG's Outstanding Elected Official in 2004.

Don served on the BL3 Regional Investment Board as it first formed, helping to create the bylaws and other operating procedures. From 1999 to 2003 Don was LCOG's rural city representative. He served as RIB chairperson in 2002. Then, when Don was appointed East Lane County Commissioner, he served as the County's representative on the RIB.

PHIL BRUBAKER BIOGRAPHY

Having worked in both the public and private sectors, Phil is keenly aware and experienced in the use of financial catalysts for economic development.

Phil was the General Manager of the Tidelands Agency for the City of Long Beach, CA. ending in the early 1980's, helping with the development of the \$25 million Downtown Long Beach Marina and the Long Beach Hyatt Regency Hotel. Later, Phil was Senior Vice President of the Los Angeles Olympic Organizing Committee from 1982 through 1985, and Mayor of the USC Olympic Village in the summer of '84.

As a real estate developer later in the 1980's, Phil was General Manager for the development of the Resort at Squaw Creek, a 416 room luxury resort in Squaw Valley, California, and more recently, he had been President of the Florence, Oregon, Chamber of Commerce, prior to his service as City Councilor and now Mayor of Florence. Since 1993, Phil has been working as a financial advisor for Carter & Carter Financial, with offices in Florence and Eugene.

Phil holds a Bachelor's Degree from Princeton University, 1968, and a Master's in Public Administration from USC, but Duck Fans, please don't hold that against him!
