Senior & Disabled Services Contracts for Services for 2006-07

Background:

At its April meeting, the LCOG Board Executive Committee approved the 2006-07 update to the 2003-07 Area Plan on Aging and Disability Services for Lane County. This Plan contained several components, one of which was a budget for services for the 2006-07 fiscal year (i.e., July 1, 2006 - June 30, 2007). This memo is to share information with the Board on the identities of the agencies, organizations, and individuals with whom Senior & Disabled Services will contract in 2006-07 to provide services that are not delivered directly by S&DS staff.

Due to the recent receipt of new federal Older Americans Act allocations, S&DS anticipates that it will need to amend many of these contracts in the near future.
