

RESOLUTION 2002-07

**ADOPTING THE AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY DETERMINATION
FOR THE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (TRANSPLAN)**

WHEREAS, the Lane Council of Governments Board has been designated by the State of Oregon as the official Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Eugene-Springfield Metropolitan Area; and

WHEREAS, the Lane Council of Governments Board is authorized by an intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement to act on matters pertaining to the transportation planning process; and

WHEREAS, the Air Quality Conformity Determination is required to secure funding for transportation projects in the area; and

WHEREAS, the Air Quality Conformity Determination under OAR 340-20-790 meets the financial constraint requirement complying with FHWA/EPA regulation 23 CFR Part 50; and

WHEREAS, the Air Quality Conformity Determination under OAR 340-20-890 meets the emissions budget as set forth in the Federal Register, Vol 58, No 232, page 64163, December 6, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the Air Quality Conformity Determination under OAR 340-20-760(4) meets the requirements for public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Air Quality Conformity Determination under OAR 340-20-760 has met the requirements for interagency consultation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LANE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

The attached Air Quality Conformity Determination for the Regional Transportation Plan (TransPlan) is hereby adopted.
