Subject: Items 5a and 5b: Presentations on OTIA III Statewide and Local Bridge Programs

In its last session, the Oregon Legislature passed the third Oregon Transportation Investment Act (OTIA III). OTIA III provides revenue over the next 10 years to improve Oregon's highways, roads and streets. The investment breakdown is as follows:

- \$1.3 billion in bond proceeds to replace and repair state bridges
- \$300 million in bond proceeds to replace and repair local bridges
- \$361 million for county and city maintenance and preservation
- \$500 million for modernization projects statewide

At the January MPC Meeting, presentations will be given on both the Statewide Bridge Program (provided by ODOT Region 3 Manager Paul Mather) and the Local Bridge Program (provided by Lane County Public Works Director Ollie Snowden).
