Subject: CABLE FRANCHISE EXTENSION.

Dear Mr. Mecham:

On October 21, 2005, Comcast gave Eugene, Springfield, Lane County, and the MPC notification that it intended to utilize the ten-year extension provision contained in Section 16(2)(f) of the franchise agreements for Eugene, Springfield, and Lane County. We provided materials indicating Comcast's compliance with the same, and personally appeared at the two succeeding meetings of the MPC following that notification.

At the MPC meeting held on November 10, 2005 the MPC requested, and we consented, to allow the MPC additional time to review the matter. Time constraints devoted to other MPC issues precluded the MPC from revisiting the issue at our appearance at the December 10, 2005 meeting. On December 20, 2005 Comcast representatives met with MPC staff and the respective governmental representatives to discuss the materials Comcast submitted.

In communications at and subsequent to the December 20th discussion, it is our understanding that the MPC is prepared to proceed with the 16(2)(f) process and seeks to establish a time frame to undertake its review and take action. It is our further understanding that MPC, City and County staff will be recommending that the MPC acknowledge that Comcast properly initiated the 16(2)(f) process and that Comcast shall be permitted to submit additional substantiating documentation after October 31, 2005, and that the MPC proceed with further information gathering in order to make a determination as called for under the respective franchise agreements. This letter and appropriate MPC action would therefore constitute mutual consent to extend the 16(2)(f) review and action period for six (6) months from now, specifically until June 30, 2006.

Accordingly, please be advised that in reliance upon the commitment that the MPC will agree to the proper initiation by Comcast of the 16(2)(f) process and the ability for Comcast to submit additional substantiating documentation after October 31, 2005, Comcast is in agreement with the request that the window for review and action upon the Comcast 16(2)(f) extension/renewal request dated October 21, 2005, be extended for a six (6) month period until June 30, 2005.

We look forward to our future discussions on these issues in the coming months and a continuing successful working relationship between Comcast and Eugene, Springfield, and Lane County.
