Subject: Item 4.b: Status of Local Transportation and Land Use Planning Activities

### **Background**

The Oregon Transportation Planning Rule (TPR) requires consistency of relevant local and regional Transportation System Plans (TSP) with an MPO's Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). As a result of the November, 2007 adoption of the MPO's updated Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), the TPR requires that local jurisdictions either make a finding of consistency for their TSP, or adopt amendments to the TSP to achieve consistency.

At the February 14, 2008 MPC meeting, MPC requested that staff provide an update on local transportation and land use planning efforts resulting from this and other requirements.

### **Discussion**

Local and regional jurisdiction staff have met with Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) and Department of Transportation (ODOT) staff for several months to discuss work to meet the TPR requirements, as well as work either underway or about to commence on other local transportation and land use planning efforts. The focus of these meetings, the most recent of which was on February 8, 2008, is agreement and coordination among the local and state jurisdictions on the work anticipated over the next several years.

The next staff meeting is scheduled for March 14, 2008. Attachment 1 to this memo presents the information that local staff will bring to that meeting for discussion with the DLCD and ODOT staff.
