| HB 2116 | Allows Department of Transportation to establish, or delegate authority to establish, designated speed on highways by process established by rule.  | 2-28 (H) Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.                    |
| HB 2163 | Prohibits city, county, district or other political subdivision from imposing taxes, fees or driver or vehicle standards related to intrastate and intercity route of provider of regular route full-service scheduled transportation of persons. | 1-17 (H) Referred to Transportation with subsequent referral to Revenue.        |
| HB 2164 | Adds two members to Oregon Transportation Commission.   | 1-17 (H) Referred to Transportation.  |
| HB 2165 | Creates Local Officials Advisory Committee to advise Oregon Transportation Commission and Department of Transportation.   | 1-17 (H) Referred to Transportation with subsequent referral to Ways and Means. |
| HB 2377 | Requires Department of Transportation to spend money on temporary bypass between Newberg and Dundee.  | 1-21 (H) Referred to Transportation with subsequent referral to Ways and Means. |
| HB 2413 | Specifies that alternative access from road or highway that is not adjoining road or highway is not reasonable when determining if access is reasonable.  | 1-26 (H) Referred to Transportation.  |

| HJR 0004      | Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to authorize use of revenues from taxes on motor vehicle fuel and on ownership and operation of motor vehicle by school districts for transportation of students. | 3-3 (H) Public Hearing scheduled.   |
| HJR 0005      | Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to allow revenue from taxes on motor vehicle fuel and ownership and operation of motor vehicles to be used for policing of highways.                              | 3-3 (H) Public Hearing scheduled.   |
| ✓ SB 0071     | Connect Oregon - Lottery Bonds for Transportation   | 2-28 (S) Public Hearing Scheduled.  |
| SB 0101       | ODOT Claims - Authorizes claim for relief against Department of Transportation if certain approach roads are closed by department.  | 2-24 (H) Referred to Transportation.  |
| SB 0102       | Highway splitting property; conveyance  | 1-31 (S) Public Hearing held.   |
| SB 0344       | Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt regulations implementing California motor vehicle emission standards beginning with 2009 model year.  | 1-24 (S) Referred to Environment and Land Use.                                |
| SB 0384       | Eliminates registration fee for hybrid vehicles.  | 1-27 (S) Referred to Transportation.  |
| SB 0492       | Revises laws regarding driver duties to certain pedestrians; see companion bill HB 2109   | 3-14 (S) Public Hearing and Possible Work Session scheduled.                  |
| SB 0566       | Prohibits Oregon Transportation Commission and Department of Transportation from designating highway or portion of highway as freight route if also designated as historic and scenic highway.              | 2-15 (S) Referred to Transportation.  |

| SB 0685       | Requires Department of Transportation to conduct study regarding feasibility of expanding number of places where U-turns are permitted.   | 2-22 (S) Referred to Transportation, then Ways and Means.             |
| ✓ SB 0777     | Establishes Multimodal Transportation Fund to make loans to public bodies and private entities for transportation projects.   | 2-23 (S) Referred to Transportation, then Ways and Means.             |
| ✓ SB 0865     | Requires Department of Transportation to conduct state highway system study for Portland metropolitan area.   | 2-24 (S) Referred to Transportation, then Ways and Means.             |
| SB 0868       | Provides for reductions in fines for excess vehicle weight if person is able to produce expired and valid variance permits and if person has not been previously fined for excess vehicle weight because of failure to renew annual variance permit for same vehicle. | 2-24 (S) Referred to Transportation.                                  |
| ✓ SB 0894     | Defines "freight route" for purpose of prohibition on reduction of capacity of state highways.  | 2-24 (S) Referred to Transportation.                                  |
| SB 0896       | Provides tax credit for employers engaged in or preparing to engage in manufacture of water transit vessels.  | 2-24 (S) Referred to Business and Economic Development, then Revenue. |
| ✓ SB 0897     | Declares statewide land use planning goals relating to transportation planning advisory only.   | 2-24 (S) Referred to Environment and Land Use.                        |
| SB 5532       | Increases amount of lottery bonds authorized to be issued by Economic and Community Development Department.   | 1-14 (S) Referred to Ways and Means.                                  |
