Subject: Item 4.b: Adopt FY07 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Action Recommended: Approve Resolution 2006-04 adopting FY07 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Background

At the March 12, 2006 MPC meeting staff presented and reviewed the draft UPWP included with this memo as Attachment 2. At the March meeting, staff outlined the purpose of the MPO and the UPWP, and described the items that are included in this federally required annual work program and indicated that adoption of the FY07 UPWP would be requested at the April 13th MPC meeting.

The work program includes the activities of the Lane Council of Governments (LCOG), the cities of Eugene, Springfield, and Coburg, Lane Transit District (LTD), Lane County, and the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT). The activities included in the UPWP reflect decisions and priorities established via other processes and products of the MPO and its partner jurisdictions. The UPWP serves as the technical and contractual document by which the MPO reflects those decisions and priorities for each fiscal year's work program.

The Transportation Planning Committee (TPC) completed its consideration of the draft UPWP and voted unanimously on March 23, 2006 to recommend that MPC adopt the draft FY2006-2007 UPWP.
