Subject: Item 4.e: Amendments to Central Lane MPO FY05-07 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP)

Action Recommended: Approve Resolution 2006-05 adopting amendments 2006-06 and 2006-07 to the FY05-07 MTIP.

Discussion

On April 13, 2006 MPC will be asked to approve Resolution 2006-05 to enact two amendments to the MTIP. The amendments are summarized below and in Exhibit A to Resolution 2006-05. Attachment 1 to this memo presents the Resolution.

At the December 8, 2005 MPC meeting, MPC directed staff “to prepare an amendment to the FY05-07 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program that bundled the time sensitive projects through June 2006 into a single motion.” At the January and February 2006 MPC meetings, MPC took action on MTIP amendments requiring action by the MPO Policy Board. These two additional amendments, which have come to light since the initial December 2005 assessment of pending time-sensitive amendments, continue to fulfill the December 8, 2005 direction. Staff will be available at the April 13th meeting to answer questions regarding the amendments if needed.

The MPO’s Transportation Planning Committee (TPC) reviewed these MTIP amendments on March 23, 2006 and unanimously recommends approval of both amendments.

Amendment 2006-06 to FY05-07 MTIP:

Add a new project (“Job Access/Reverse Commute (JARC)”), funded by SAFETEA-LU authorization, for development and maintenance of job access/reverse commute projects under 49 USC 5316.

Amendment 2006-07 to FY05-07 MTIP:

Add a new project (“New Freedom”), funded by SAFETEA-LU authorization, to provide transportation services and alternatives beyond ADA under 49 USC 5317.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 2006-05 (Attachment 1), adopting MTIP Amendments #2006-06 and #2006-07 as summarized above.
