Subject: Item 4.b: Adopt FY08 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Action Recommended: Adopt Resolution 2007-04 adopting the Central Lane Metropolitan Planning Organization FY2007-2008 Unified Planning Work Program

Background

At the March 8, 2007 MPC meeting staff presented and reviewed the draft UPWP included with this memo as Attachment 2. At the March meeting, staff outlined the purpose of the UPWP, and described the items that are included in this federally required annual work program and indicated that adoption of the FY08 UPWP would be requested at the April 12th MPC meeting.

The work program includes the activities of the Lane Council of Governments (LCOG), the cities of Eugene, Springfield, and Coburg, Lane Transit District (LTD), Lane County, and the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT). The activities included in the UPWP reflect decisions and priorities established via other processes and products of the MPO and its partner jurisdictions. The UPWP serves as the technical and contractual document by which the MPO reflects those decisions and priorities for each fiscal year's work program.

The Transportation Planning Committee (TPC) completed its consideration of the draft UPWP and voted unanimously on March 22, 2007 to recommend that MPC adopt the draft FY2007-2008 UPWP, pending consideration of any comments received during the public comment period.

A public comment period on the draft FY08 UPWP is currently open until 5:00 p.m. on April 11, 2007. As of the writing of this memo, no comments have been received. At the April 12th MPC meeting staff will report on any comments received between the writing of this memo and the close of the public comment period.
