Subject: Item 4b: TGM Project for Refinement of TransPlan TDM Element

As discussed last month, LCOG is currently engaged in the development of a preliminary TDM Refinement Plan; both to lay the groundwork for a response to TPR requirements and to better integrate TDM activities in the region with the implementation of Nodal Development, BRT and other elements of TransPlan. As noted last month, the intent has been to use the grant resource to develop the background research and analysis of individual TDM strategies and alternative packages of strategies to produce a framework that can be taken into the three-year update when it begins in July.

The scope of the grant project entailed 3 broad tasks:

1. Identify specific TDM actions to compliment the implementation of Nodal Development and the BRT
2. Extend TDM project list to the planning horizon of the three-year update (2030)
3. Prepare a draft TDM Refinement Plan

This draft will serve as a beginning point for the development of the TDM element of the three-year update. It should be noted that, as part of the update process, the draft presented in May could undergo significant change depending on other elements of the update, public input, and policy direction from MPC.

Attached is a copy of the Preliminary Draft of the TransPlan Transportation Demand Management Element. Staff will provide an overview of the plan at the May 8th meeting.

Also note that the map referenced in the document was still undergoing revisions at time of mail out. Staff will distribute copies at the MPC meeting on May 8th.

Action Requested: Review Preliminary Draft Refinement Plan and provide comments.
