Subject: Item 4.e: Amendments to FY2005-2007 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP)

Action Recommended: Approve Resolution 2005-06, adopting amendments to MTIP.

Discussion

On May 12th, MPC will be asked to amend the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) to delete two Coburg projects funded in part with the MPO's Surface Transportation Program, Urban (STP-U) funds. Attachments 2 and 3 to this memo present the amendment packages.

The City of Coburg has requested that these projects be removed from the programmed MTIP. Coburg has indicated that the Diamond and Locust Street overlays are not priority capital improvement projects at this time and that the City's required 10% match would better be utilized on a project to preserve Roberts Road.

Since these projects were partially funded with the MPO's STP-U funds in the amount of \$54,000 total, upon amending the MTIP to delete the projects those STP-U funds would revert to "unallocated" status and be available for programming for other qualifying projects in the MPO.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 2005-06 (Attachment 1), adopting MTIP Amendments #2005-16 and #2005-17, as shown in the attached amendment packages.
