

**RESOLUTION 2005-06**

**ADOPTING AMENDMENTS #2005-16 AND #2005-17 TO THE CENTRAL LANE MPO METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FY2005 to 2007**

**WHEREAS**, the Lane Council of Governments Board has been designated by the State of Oregon as the official Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Central Lane region; and

**WHEREAS**, the LCOG Board has delegated responsibility for MPO policy functions to the Metropolitan Policy Committee (MPC), a committee of officials from Eugene, Springfield, Coburg, Lane County, Lane Transit District, and ODOT; and

**WHEREAS**, federal regulations require that transportation projects using several categories of federal funds and projects that are regionally significant for air quality purposes be included in the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coburg has identified two projects currently programmed in the MTIP which use federal funds and has indicated that the City does not currently wish to use those federal funds for the programmed projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coburg has requested that said projects be deleted from the MTIP.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

That the Metropolitan Policy Committee adopts the attached amendments to the FY2005-2007 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program.
