Subject: Item 4.i.1.iii: TGM and TE Grant Awards

At the January 11, 2007 MPC meeting, MPC approved a letter to the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) prioritizing the two City of Eugene Transportation Enhancement (TE) Program grant applications that advanced to the grant selection stage as the first and second priorities for TE funding in the Central MPO. The MPO's first priority – Delta Ponds Multiuse Path – was awarded a \$1 million TE grant. At the April 12, 2007 MPC meeting, MPC approved a letter of endorsement to the Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) Program for an LCOG application for funding for the Coburg Multimodal Loop Implementation Strategy. The TGM program has awarded the full \$65,000 grant amount requested for this project, to be funded in the FY08-10 biennium.
