Subject: Item 4.b: MTIP Project Amendment

**Action Recommended:** Hold Public Hearing. Adopt Resolution 2004-03 amending MTIP to add ODOT EIS Project.

### **Issue Summary**

At the October 9, 2003 MPC meeting MPC adopted the FY2004-06 Central Lane Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP). The MTIP lists transportation projects using federal funds programmed for fiscal years 2004-2006. The MTIP also lists all non-federal funding sources for individual projects.

As described in item 4.a on the May 13, 2004 MPC agenda, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is requesting an amendment to the FY04-06 Central Lane MPO MTIP. This amendment would be to add a project, as described further in Attachment 1 to the May 13<sup>th</sup> item, to reflect the recent approval of \$2.75 million in OTIA III funding for EIS work on the replacement structure on I-5 crossing the Willamette River. The amendment would program the OTIA III funds in FY2004 under ODOT's project listings.

MPC opened a public comment period on the proposed draft MTIP amendment at the May 13, 2004 meeting. The public comment period will remain open until the June 10, 2004 MPC meeting. As of the date of this memo, staff has not received any public comment on the proposed amendment.

At its April 22, 2004 meeting, TPC unanimously agreed to forward this draft MTIP amendment to MPC and recommended that MPC open the public comment period from May 13 to June 10, 2004. TPC further recommended, pending public input and a public hearing before MPC on June 10, that MPC adopt the MTIP amendment on June 10, 2004.
