Subject: Item 4.g.1.ii: Administrative Amendments to FFY08-11 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP)

**Action Recommended: None. Information only.**

The MTIP must be maintained so as to accurately reflect the funding and timing of all federally funded and regionally significant projects within the MPO area.

The following administrative amendments were considered and unanimously approved by the MPO's Transportation Planning Committee (TPC) at their meeting on May 22, 2008:

**2008-26:** OR99: Barger Ave to Washington/Jefferson Preservation/Safety. (ODOT)  
Slips construction from FFY09 to FFY10.

**2008-27:** Region 2 Illumination. (ODOT)  
Combines two existing federally-funded lighting projects for efficiency.  
Construction will be in 2010.

The following administrative amendment was considered and unanimously approved by the MPO's Transportation Planning Committee (TPC) at their meeting on June 26, 2008:

**2008-28:** Region 2 Signal Replacements: Replace existing traffic signal systems at various sites where the existing signals have reached the end of their life cycle. Includes one signal in Springfield and additional signals outside of MPO. (ODOT)  
Add project to MTIP with no MPO funding decision.

These amendments do not affect air quality conformity or fiscal constraint. There are no changes in cost. For these reasons, they are considered administrative in nature. Full details on the amendments can be found at <http://www.thempo.org/committees/tpc.cfm>.
