Re: I-5/Franklin Proposed Interchange, "Interchange 101" Presentation

The goal of this agenda item is to provide MPC with an "Interchange 101" overview of the elements and issues involved with interchange design. Mr. Brian Ray, Kittleson and Associates, will present an overview of design concepts, federal guidelines, and best practices in interchange development. The project management team staff has participated in a more detailed review of this material with Mr. Ray, and believes that an awareness of the basics of interchange design and development will be quite useful to decision makers throughout the course of this project.

Several sketch-level draft concept categories for interchange connections to I-5 will also be presented to contextualize the issues. These categories of interchange concepts were developed by the consultant team, with review and input from the Project Management Team, to frame the range of options. These concepts will go forward for high-level environmental, operational, engineering and cost analysis in September and October. In November, the results of this analysis are scheduled to be presented to each of your governing bodies, prior to being presented in public open house forums across the community.
