Subject: Item 4.e: Commuter Solutions 2005-2010 Strategic Plan

Background

The Commuter Solutions Program is the region's Transportation Options (or Transportation Demand Management/TDM) program. Commuter Solutions is partially funded by the MPO through MPC's allocation of STP-U funds. Additional funding comes from the ODOT STIP (about \$100,000 a year), local agency contributions (\$20,000) and from Business Energy Tax Credit program funds for partial administration of the LTD Student Transit Pass Program. The Commuter Solutions program is housed at Lane Transit District and supplies local and state jurisdictions with support services that include research, public outreach, education and congestion management services.

Commuter Solutions staff will review highlights of the 2005-2010 Strategic Plan and recent program accomplishments.
