Background and Actions to Date	The PSCC Policy Committee annually adopts a fiscal year work plan to guide the work of the PSCC in fulfilling these goals and statutory requirements. The Policy Committee has been working since June 2002 to adopt the work plan for 2002-03. Final work plan amendments were proposed at the January Policy Committee meeting. The attached 2002-03 PSCC Work Plan was approved and adopted by the Policy Committee at their February 3 rd meeting.

Pertinent Policy	<p>The PSCC directs its work toward fulfilling three goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GOAL #1 Have a system in place that monitors, evaluates, and recommends improvements for the effectiveness of the community safety system. • GOAL #2 Review governance models and make recommendations that support cooperative and coordinated approaches to community safety. • GOAL #3 Have a continuum of services and sanctions in place based on proven best practices that promote community safety. <p>The PSCC is directed by Oregon state statute to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop and recommend a plan for the use of state resources to serve the local adult and juvenile offender population which must coordinate community wide services involving prevention, treatment, and intervention strategies; • Coordinate local criminal and juvenile justice policy among affected criminal justice entities; and • In consultation with the Commission on Children and Families, develop and recommend a plan aimed at crime prevention and to prevent criminal involvement by youth.
