This 3-hour videoconference, presented by the National Institute of Corrections, equips community corrections administrators with a general understanding of managed behavioral health care, a planning process to ensure services for the mentally ill, and recommendations on how community corrections administrators can become active participants in securing behavioral health care services for offenders under their supervision.

The program will help participants:

- Understand mental illness and its impact on individuals in community corrections;
- Understand special issues with behavioral managed care in criminal justice;
- Understand the history and components of managed behavioral health care;
- Understand what constitutes good managed behavioral health care and what has not worked;
- Learn about legal issues and liabilities related to behavioral health and community corrections;
- Learn strategies for collaboration between service providers and community corrections; and
- Understand the role of mental health care supervision.

This program is suitable for community corrections administrators, including agency directors, deputies, or supervisors of specialized mental health units; probation and parole field supervisors; residential and structured living program supervisors; day reporting center administrators; jail administrators supervising offenders in the community; judges, prosecutors, and defense counsel; public health personnel; and advocacy groups.
