

Errata Sheets for
Community Corrections Act Programs in Lane County
Evaluation Report: 2001-2002

Due to errors in data transmission to LCOG, results reported for the CCA service program Lane County Mental Health (LCMH) Case Management were for the wrong group of offenders. This effects several sections of the evaluation report. These errata sheets are designed to replace pages 20-21, 36, 47, and 56-57 in the original report as well as both Appendix tables (pages 62 and 63). Page numbers are included in the errata sheets with the addition of the letter 'a' added and blank pages are inserted in order to make the new pages fit with the original page breaks.

Most of the changes involved simply replacing data summaries for LCMH Case Management with a summaries produced from the correct program data. Pages 56-57 describe an analysis of multiple program involvement by CCA services program participants. This analysis was re-run with the new data and, since the data error had resulted in Case Management participants being largely duplicated from LCMH Sex Offender clients, the results are substantially altered from the original analysis.

In addition to the corrections related to LCMH Case Management data, a request was made during the November 19 Community Corrections Committee meeting to examine recidivism rates across programs for "new" crimes only. LCOG staff completed this analysis, filtering out AIRS charges coded with one or more procedural violation modifiers, and the results were added as a new row to the table entitled Program Summary: Outcomes and Initial Recidivism Measures (page63a). In order to assist in the examination of these results, a chart, titled Recidivism Rates for All Programs ("new" charges only) was also included with these errata sheets.
