You have three agenda topics for your meeting.

Gretchen Pierce, Community Corrections Committee (CCC) Chair, will review and ask for your comments on the Supervisory Authority Team (SAT) being proposed by the CCC. This is in response to the IGA assignment referencing a single supervisory authority and a seamless criminal justice system. Material is enclosed for your review. There are two documents. One provides some historical information with the recommendation for the SAT. The other document proposes a process for responding to potential state cuts in funding. If this process works, the CCC will be proposing it for use in developing the Community Corrections Plan.

The second agenda topic is the PSCC Work Plan for the 2002-2003 year. I will be reviewing the various projects in the Work Plan and the costs associated with each project. You will be asked to prioritize the work so staff will know which direction you want to take if there is additional work proposed or the budget is reduced. The Work Plan and costs are enclosed for your review.

The third item is the initial discussion regarding protocol for the AIRS Conversion project and any other data projects. As you may recall, this discussion began at your last meeting. You expressed a desire to ensure that data systems being developed are designed with research and analytical capabilities and to discuss the accuracy of the data that is in the system. You requested a presentation from AIRS staff at this meeting. Unfortunately, Judy Monahan, AIRS Director, is out of town and unable to attend. Bob Clayton, the LCOG Data Warehouse Coordinator, will be present to discuss the challenges he has discovered from working with the AIRS system. Byron Vanderpool, who will be staffing this committee until my position is refilled, is also very familiar with the AIRS conversion process and can answer your questions.
