

Evaluations of Community Safety-Related Programs and Projects in Lane County

During its October 24th meeting, the R&E Committee of the Lane County Public Safety Coordinating Council directed LCOG staff to produce for the December 5th meeting a list of all of the community-safety related programs in Lane County and whether or not each has been formally evaluated. In response to this request, LCOG staff contacted each member of the Community Corrections Committee, asking each to supply a list of their department/agency's programs and whether they have been evaluated.

Staff received information from the Sheriff's Office, Parole and Probation, and Lane County Mental Health. In addition, staff compiled information from LCOG sources.
