Subject: Item 6: Draft Oregon MPO Consortium (OMPOC) Legislative Priorities

Action Recommended: Provide input to the Metropolitan Policy Committee regarding draft OMPOC Legislative Priorities.

The purpose of this agenda item is to give the CAC the opportunity to provide input to the Metropolitan Policy Committee (MPC) on the draft OMPOC Legislative Priorities document. These are OMPOC's draft priorities for the 2009 Oregon State Legislative session. An earlier version of the document was distributed and briefly discussed at the November 2008 CAC meeting. At that time, the CAC requested further opportunity to review the document and provide input if the MPC did not act on the document at their December meeting.

The current version of the document is included as Attachment 1 to this memo and reflects the Transportation Planning Committee's (TPC) recommendation for slight revisions to the "Jurisdictional Transfers" language. TPC also recommended slight revisions to the "Transit" language in the document – Lane Transit District (LTD) staff is still drafting that revised language and it is anticipated that the revised language will be available for CAC review by the time of the December 17 CAC meeting.

TPC has recommended that MPC endorse the draft OMPOC Legislative Priorities document, including the language revisions noted above. MPC is scheduled to consider endorsement at their January 8, 2009 meeting, prior to OMPOC's consideration and action on the document later in January.
