PROJECT SUMMARY: Conduct a project development process to refine the approved Environmental Assessment (EA) preferred alternative for the Gateway/Beltline intersection and conduct a public involvement process with a steering committee of property owners and businesses to assess project alternatives. Refinement of the alternative will involve reviewing driveway locations, property easements for access, intersection designs, traffic projections, and width and location of road alignments

ACTION REQUESTED:

- delete existing MTIP project/phase
- add new MTIP project/phase
- change existing MTIP project/phase

REASON FOR REQUEST:

Add \$200K in local funds (City of Springfield) to existing project. These extra funds are for unanticipated traffic analysis complexities, and to fill design model gaps to survey accuracy in order that the design can inform the stakeholder process on access, circulation and ROW acquisition decisions.
